Therefore,

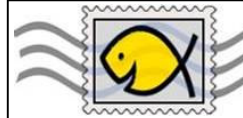
The right response toward God is faith and humble worship.

GOD, THE HOLY TRINITY

Isaiah 40:18-28

GOD IS

Hebrews 11:6 tells us that nobody can come to God unless they believe that “He is”. As we have already said, the whole world knows that “God is” but they suppress this truth and remain in ignorance of all that God is.

☞ GOD IS...A SPIRIT

Jesus taught this truth to an ordinary woman (John 4:24).

1. What are some consequences of God being Spirit?

2. If then, He is Spirit, why does the bible often speak about God in physical terms, as having eyes, ears and hands?

God is not *something*, He is *Someone*. (Ex 33:11; Jas 2:23).

- God is Personal

Therefore,

Since God is unseen, He cannot be known completely from what is seen. He must also be known through language (words) that we can understand.

☞ ...GOD IS VERY GREAT

- As far as space is concerned, God is everywhere (omnipresent. Jer 23:24)
- As far as time is concerned, He is eternal (Ps 90:2)
- As far as knowledge is concerned, He knows everything (omniscient. Ps 147:5)
- As far as power is concerned, He does whatever He chooses (omnipotent. Ps 115:3)

☞ ...GOD IS SELF EXISTENT

- He is not dependant on any created being
- He is the fountain of His own being and everything else
- Romans 11:34-36

3. What does this passage say about God regarding His Creation?

☞ ...GOD IS ONE GOD

This is one of the most basic teachings of the Word of God (Deut 6:4; 4:35)

☞ ...GOD IS THREE PERSONS

The Old Testament prepares us for the truth that there is more than one who is God. (Gen 1:26-27; Isa 6:8)

- The Father is God (Matt 6:9)
- The Son, Jesus, is God (John 1:1-3; 20:25)
- The Spirit is God (1 Cor 6:11; Rom 8:33)

Yet each Person is distinct (John 15:26; 16:13-15)
